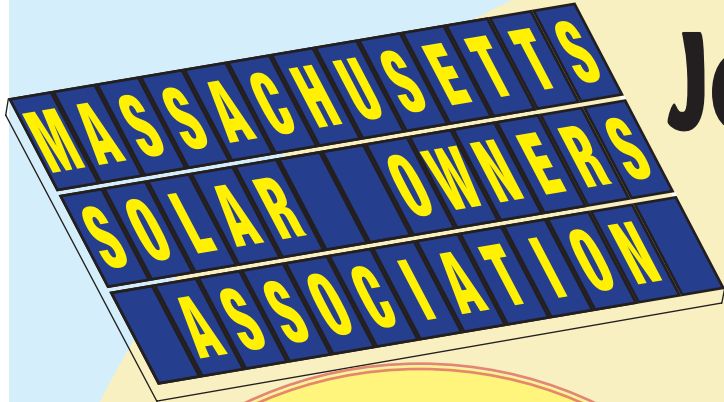

Why Join?

Although Solar Energy has had considerable success in our state, it is now under attack by the Utilities, local zoning bylaws, and even the DOER (Dept. of Energy Resources). A Solar Task Force (utilities/DOER) is considering future solar PV to be kept "behind the meter" and levy a penalty fee on current solar PV exporters. **If you own solar, this will apply to you!** The DOER will propose new regulations for SRECs and RECs, and for those of you planning new solar or expand, get ready for the SREC2 program tht will severely limit many forms of solar growth. Over the last few years anti-solar groups have added new zoning bylaws that will prevent solar installations even on a home.

Who? Like you, we are committed to solar thermal (Hot Water) and Photovoltaic (Electric) installations. Over the years we have seen many policy changes in state, federal and local regulations and incentives, and found there were few sources of reliable and unbiased information.
